Day 1 September 3: Auckland/Haikou (In-flight meals)

Make your own way to Auckland Airport, check in, and fly to China.

·Day 2 September 4: Haikou/Arrive in Hangzhou/Puyuan (Lunch/Dinner)

Transfer in Haikou to Hangzhou, then head to Tongxiang [Puyuan]. "Step into a painting, dream back a thousand years in a day." Puyuan Fashion Ancient Town features Southern Song Dynasty architectural styles, with a network of waterways, preserving the Jiangnan water town charm of "parallel water and land," "riverside streets," and "riverside pavilions." The chessboard-like streets, riverside corridors, and courtyard spaces are well-preserved, creating a captivating water town landscape.

Accommodation: Puyuan Hotel 5-star or similar

·Day 3 September 5: Puyuan/Wuxi (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

After breakfast, enjoy free time. Depart for Wuxi at 10:00. Arrive and have lunch, then visit [Lingshan Grand Buddha I scenic area, home to the world's tallest standing bronze Buddha statue. The serene layout, grand architecture, and exquisite craftsmanship offer unparalleled visual and spiritual experiences. Visit [Purple Sand Museum .

Accommodation: Youxiangjia Hotel 5-star or similar

·Day 4 September 6: Wuxi (Breakfast/Lunch)

After breakfast, visit [Three Kingdoms City] by Taihu Lake, take an ancient warship tour, and enjoy a live horse battle show. Visit Wuxi [Pearl Exhibition Center]. Lunch features Wuxi specialty dumplings and soup dumplings. In the afternoon, take a [Ancient Canal boat tour] at Nanchang Street, followed by free time. Dinner is self-arranged with local snacks.

Accommodation: Youxiangjia Hotel 5-star or similar

·Day 5 September 7: Wuxi/Suzhou (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

After breakfast, head to Suzhou. Visit [Master of the Nets Garden], a famous classical Chinese private garden. After lunch, visit [Panmen], the only remaining water-and-land double gate, then explore [Shantang Street] to experience Suzhou's riverside life.

Accommodation: Suyuan Hotel 5-star or similar

•Day 6 September 8: Suzhou/Shanghai (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)
After breakfast, visit [Suzhou Silk Factory], then head to Shanghai. After lunch, visit [The Bund], located along the Huangpu River in central Shanghai, featuring 52 buildings of various architectural styles, known as the "Exhibition of World Architecture." Visit [Yu Garden], a classical Jiangnan garden from the Ming Dynasty, known for its lush greenery, ancient trees, and intricate layout. Optional evening activity: Shanghai Acrobatics Show (NZD 80/person).

Accommodation: Yuanzhou Yiting Hotel Quasi 5-star or similar

·Day 7 September 9: Shanghai/Hangzhou (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

After breakfast, visit [People's Square] and [Nanjing Road], then [World Cultural Heritage Art Exhibition Center ]. After lunch, head to Hangzhou. In the afternoon, visit West Lake scenic area: [Hua Gang Guan Yu], [West Lake boat tour], [Su Causeway], and [Leifeng Pagoda]. West Lake is renowned for its scenic beauty and lush vegetation, inspiring countless poets and stories, including the famous "Legend of the

·Day 8 September 10: Hangzhou (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

After breakfast, visit [Hangzhou International Expo Center], the main venue for the G20 Summit. After lunch, visit [Six Harmonies Pagoda] and [Meijiawu Tea Plantation] to taste Hangzhou's famous Longjing

Accommodation: Holiday Inn 4-star or similar

·Day 9 September 11: Hangzhou/Haikou (Breakfast/Lunch)

After breakfast, enjoy free time at [Qinghefang Ancient Street] for shopping and exploration. After lunch, transfer to the airport for the flight back to Auckland.

·Day 10 September 12: Auckland

Arrive in Auckland in the morning.
